





Is Kenner Simmentals a farm or a ranch? It is a

diversified operation. We calve 450 cows. The farming side is also a large operation. I used to help on the farm side years ago, but as the cattle side grew, I didn't have the time to help over there. In emergencies, I will help when needed.

What is your least favorite job on the farm/ranch?

Taking pictures! It's one of the more vital aspects of putting a catalog together, but also one of the most frustrating when trying to get them set up. It's usually colder than heck when the perfect days are to get great pictures.

What is your favorite job or time of year on the farm/ranch? When everything is out on grass after Al'ing. By

that time, we are tired of cows, as the cows are probably tired of us! Once they get out on grass everyone has a new perspective and they look so much better.

TRAXINGER SIMMENTALS NAMED 2022 PIONEER RECIPIENT BY ND SIMMENTAL ASSOCIATION

The 2022 ND Simmental Association Pioneer Award was presented to Mike and Terri Traxinger.

When Mike was notified he won the award, he replied, "There are others that deserve this more." After trying to suggest other nominees to avoid the limelight, his efforts were unsuccessful and Mike and Terri were presented the award at the ND Simmental Association banquet.

In 1969, the first Simmental were introduced to their farm, which were of the Fleckvieh influence. With an ASA membership number of 8105, you know he was a pioneer in the industry! He held his first bull sale in Leola, SD in the mid-70's.

He went to an AI school, and bred 25 head to TH Counselor Baron. Evidently, he must have been paying attention, since he got 24 to stick AI! He then bought 10 open heifers and 10 bred heifers from his father and started his herd.

He chose the Fleckvieh strain of Simmental because they were bred to utilize forage better than other cattle. He believed in them whole-heartedly, but when color became an issue, he started breeding more solid color, as well as adding black cattle to the herd. In 1995, he also purchased a bull from Shafer's Shoestring Ranch by the name of Shoestring Black DNA 175C, which was the first homo black tested bull in the breed.

While the kids were growing up, they helped their kids show and in the youth programs. They have always supported youth programs and have served on numerous boards in the cattle industry.

A highlight for him was when he and Bill Begger had the honor to judge the Pen shows at the National Western Stock Show in Denver.

Some people say the German-Russian heritage causes people to be a bit stubborn at times. This shines through when he is bidding on a bull or an elite female. He is a worthy adversary!

When interviewed in 1993, in the Aberdeen American News, he was quoted, "New developments in genetics and biology have taken cattle ranching quickly into the age of high technology. The cattle business is really getting high tech," he said. I bet he'd never imagined then how high tech the industry would be now!

Raising cattle is like building a house he said. If you work hard and give people a good product you can get a premium for it.

Mike is not a man that necessarily likes change, but he will make changes when needed to maintain the level of excellence it takes to be a good seedstock producer. Where he is now is a testament to that.

> His philosophy is, "I've made a lot of good friends in the cattle industry. Without friends and family, you have nothing." Well said!

Each year at his bull sale, he reiterates the reason he does this is for the customers and friends he's acquired along this journey.

He doesn't do it for the recognition. He just loves cattle and the challenges of trying to make them better, and he loves the people in the Simmental family!

This year's promoter of the year family calls North Central Morton County home. They got their start in the Simmental business by buying commercial Simmental heifers from Bob Brown. The spring of 2005 was the first-year bulls were marketed through the Dakota Xpress annual production sale. They continued selling bulls with Dakota Xpress until 2014. In the spring of 2013, they experienced some unexpected health problems that made them decide to go out on their own. In 2015 they held their first production sale at the ranch via video auction and have continued holding the sale at the ranch the first Friday of February.

A few things they're looking for when purchasing bulls is Butts, nuts, and guts. Beyond that, the cow behind any bull or heifer they purchase will be good as they study cow cards rigorously. Everything always goes back to a good cow to make a successful prodigy. While visiting the one who spear heads the operation, I asked him, what are a few things you're trying to achieve while breeding registered cattle? In response, he told me they were trying to produce a bunch of uniform calves that are easily marketable and grow fast and easily. Easy fleshing cows that work and thrive in many different environments raise big calves and breed back every year. In my closing, Dusty Kunkel said, "this is an award for the entire family as everyone helps in some way, shape or form." A couple of his favorite quotes is "Just live one day at a time. Live each day as you're dealt it. Set goals and when you achieve them set higher goals." With that being said, we are proud to announce this year's promoter of the year goes to Kunkel Simmentals.



TIME TO RETIRE: Nancy Jo Bateman has been serving as the executive director of the North Dakota Beef Commission since 1984, and officially retires from her post Dec. 31.

NANCY JO BATEMAN IS SET TO RETIRE FROM THE NORTH DAKOTA BEEF COMMISSION AFTER 38 YEARS This article first appeared in Dakota Farmer,

After nearly four decades serving as executive director for the North Dakota Beef Commission, Nancy Jo Bateman will retire.

"I felt like now is the right time," Bateman says. "I have great staff that are doing a super job, and having a couple new grandbabies didn't hurt."

After growing up on her family's farm in Kindred, N.D., Bateman graduated from North Dakota State University in 1981 with a bachelor's degree in food and nutrition. "I always had an interest in animal science and meats, in particular," Bateman says. "I had an animal science and communications minor while at NDSU."

Her first career was with the North Dakota Dairy and Promotion Council, where she worked until 1984. "I have to give credit to Dr. Verlon K. Johnston. I was one of just a few gals in the animal science program, and we all have an agriculture background, and he took us under his wing," she says. Bateman says Johnston was the reason she started her career at the North Dakota Dairy Promotion Council in 1981, after he told her to apply for the job. "My first thought was I was glad someone's looking for a job for me."

She worked as assistant manager at the council until 1984, when she started her career at the North Dakota Beef Commission as its executive director.

"The beef commission only had one employee at the time," Bateman recalls. Sylvia Barone was the commission's sole employee, who was hired when the beef commission was created in 1973. "When I started, we didn't even have a computer here. There's been monumental changes over time."

A CHANGING INDUSTRY

Bateman says when she first started her role as executive director, the beef checkoff funding was just 50 cents a head. "It started out as 10 cents a head, then moved to 25. Then when I started, it just

increased to 50 cents," she says. Now, checkoff is \$2 a head — just \$1.50 more than in 1984.

That change has amounted to millions of dollars over the years. "That extra money has really allowed us to do some great things," she says, "both within the state and on behalf of our producers."

While keeping up with inflation is a difficult part of their program planning, Bateman says they work to put on deliberate and effective programs to get producers the biggest return on their investment.

Beef advocacy looks a little different today than it did in 1984, Bateman says. The ability to have instantaneous connections has provided different benefits and challenges for commodity groups.

"Our world is so much closer than it was 30 or 40 years ago," she says. "It used

to take a reporter time to write a story and publish it, and now everything's instant. If we have a big issue like BSE, it's instantaneous for the media, and so it can be a challenge for any commodity group to stay on top of."

Not only is the beef industry different than it was in 1984, but also beef producers and ranchers have a whole different set of management practices. "The science of genetics and feeding and everything that helps us make cattle more efficient has just made a world of difference," Bateman says.

Another development for the beef industry has been research and development into beef retail cuts and the availability of easy-to-prepare meat. "Everything was just cut into chuck roasts," Bateman says. "Now, we pull out the flat irons, the ranch steaks — all those different cuts were a learning curve to add for retailers, packers and processors."

Bateman says she worked to get producers familiar with these cuts by specially ordering them for lunches and meetings, and providing recipes and cooking methods for these new cuts. "The muscle was there all along, but we were now able to get the proper value for those cuts because of what they bring to the table," she says.

Bateman says incredible leaders in the

beef industry were the reason for the success of some of these changes. "Breed organizations have done a tremendous job, our animal scientists and meat scientists and their years of experiences are at the core of moving our industry forward," she says.

HOW DO YOU PICK A FAVORITE?

"The first national cattle industry convention I even went to in January of '85 stands out," Bateman says. "That was the one where the industry decided to push forward and get the dollar-per-head checkoff passed."

Another memorable experience was the Denver national convention during George W. Bush's presidency. "We knew they had invited the president, but everyone was being very tight-lipped about it," Bateman says. "Just everything that went into that happening was fascinating to watch."

Bateman recalls husband Rocky's excitement of seeing the president. "He's been involved in politics and was in the legislature for six years," she says. "Rocky got up in the middle of the night to get up to the front row. We knew he'd be down shaking hands for a few minutes after he spoke, and Rocky got his handshake."

EXCITED FOR WHAT'S NEXT

Without knowing an official count, Bateman might just be the longestrunning executive director of a state beef commission. "There's a couple that have been here probably 30 years, a lot of longtimers," she says. "There were a handful of us who all had our families at the same times. We'd get together at meetings and compare notes and laugh about everything we went through."

Family has played a pivotal role in Bateman's success, she says. Their three daughters — Jessie Bateman-Pfaff, Ashley Bateman-Abrahamson and Libby Bateman — all work in some part of the agriculture industry. "It's cool that the girls have all gone through an animal science program, each with a different focus," she says.

Bateman and her daughters are the fifth and sixth generations, respectively, on their home farm in New Salem, N.D. "Jessie and her husband have the lion's share of the cattle, and Rocky has cropland and no-till fields he focuses on," she says.

"I've got a list," Bateman says when asked what she'll do during her retirement. "There have been some things going on I've been waiting a long time to do. I've gotten the chance to meet amazing people all over the country, so you never know what will happen."

Bateman officially retired from the ND Beef Commission on Dec. 31.






